The FNQ Vocational Academy program is delivered over two years. The program provides students a pathway to study senior secondary subjects, participate in vocational training, and complete work experience. At the successful completion of the program, students will have obtained their Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE), completed or worked toward a vocational qualification, and have a confirmed employment or further education/training pathway. In addition, students will have gained vocational experience and developed the knowledge and skills to be successful in their chosen career. Students will also have the opportunity to gain a school-based apprenticeship or traineeship.

- Year 11 - Students will attend 2 days of school, 1 day of vocational training, and 1 to 2 days of work experience each week
- Year 12 - Students will attend 2 days of school, and 1 to 3 days of work (if vocational training has been completed)
- Students undertaking a School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeship are ineligible to concurrently complete additional vocational training, therefore it is anticipated that they will attend 2 days of school, and 3 days of work (negotiated with the employer)

WHY CHOOSE US?

By focusing on career goals and industry pathways first, FNQ Vocational Academy can offer flexible, tailored approaches to school delivery and management of student outcomes, resulting in student's being resilient and ready as they enter the workforce or move onto further education and training opportunities.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- completed Year 10 or equivalent
- be at least 15 years of age, and
- demonstrated consistent engagement at school through positive behaviour, attendance and academic progress – this will be reviewed and discussed at the enrolment interview

TIMETABLES

- School is scheduled from 8:30am to 2:30pm, 2 days each week (Mon/Tue OR Thu/Fri)
- School is delivered at TAFE Queensland Cairns Campus
- Students will enrol in five core subjects and courses:
 - Essential English
 - Essential Maths
 - Social and Community Studies
 - FNS20210 Certificate II in Financial Services
 - FSK20119 Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways
